Why this lineup

STRATEGY

Objective was spread the danger — no two weak bats back to back, cleanup untouched — so I split the eleven batters into six strong and five weak on Fall 2026 form read against career, then alternated the weak half through slots 2, 5, 7, 9 and 11. The two calls that shaped the card: Casey Klimek takes slot 4 outright (2.542 this fall, hit in both games, HR and 3B) with Owen Vahey leading off on a 7-for-8 start, and Brayden Owens drops to 10 despite a 1.967 career because his only fall game is an 0-3 — that's form, not a demotion. The deliberate inversions are Dustin Klimek batting 8th and Douglas Bonness 5th: strong bats are spent low on purpose and the hot-but-thin bats get slotted between them, so this order looks nothing like descending OPS or the 9/1 card.
