Why this lineup

STRATEGY

Objective: no dead spots — with an even 10-man roster the five weak bats can only be kept apart by strict alternation, so weak bats hold slots 1/3/5/7/9 and strong bats hold 2/4/6/8/10, which means giving up a strong leadoff to protect cleanup (the strategy's stated trade). The two calls that shaped this card: Owen Vahey lands at 4 on current form (.818/.833/1.455 this fall, a hit and a homer in each of the last two games), and Brayden Owens — career 2.058, third-best bat on paper — drops all the way to 10 because among strong bats the power plays later and his 7-PA fall sample (a 2-3 with a triple and homer sandwiched against an 0-3) is the thinnest of the group. Trevor Millen sits at 6 per the coach's standing "middle of the lineup" instruction, which is also the strong slot immediately behind cleanup.
