Why this lineup

STRATEGY

Per the manager's "protect the top" directive, slots 1-5 are drawn exclusively from the eight players with 29+ PA: Millen and Casey Klimek set the table on the two highest OBPs on the roster (.810, .800), Dustin Klimek and Owen Vahey form the heart (2.085 OPS and a roster-best 1.436 SLG with 8 HR), and Aaron Smith backs them at 5 on the largest sample on the team (46 PA, .761 OBP). Allison and Valentin take 6-7 as the next-best well-sampled bats, with the three light-sample hitters (Perry 20 PA, Jacob 11 PA, Pellerin 22 PA) held to 8-10 as instructed — placement there reflects sample size and the manager's rule, not a judgment that they are weak. Note that the supplied analysis calls the slot effect indeterminate at 481 PA and caps the whole reordering gain at ~0.2 runs/game, so I judged every hitter on their own line and did not move anyone based on how a slot has produced; positions below are just each player's first listed spot as requested.
